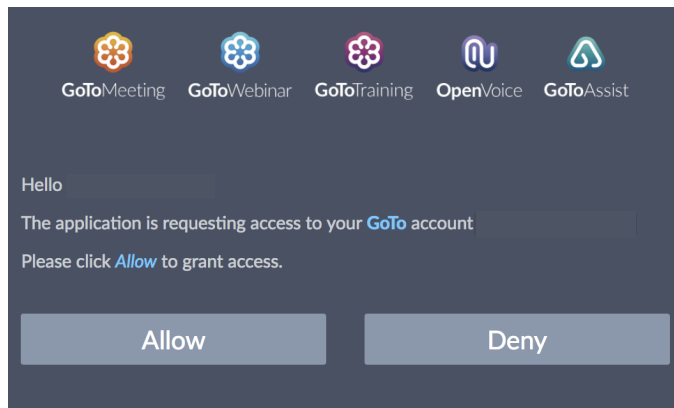

GoToMeeting Integration

Step 1: Connect GoToMeeting

- Log into GoToMeeting
- Return to the DataGrail connections window and click Connect GoToMeeting
- When prompted, click Allow



- When connected, a green check mark will then appear on the GoToMeeting integration tile

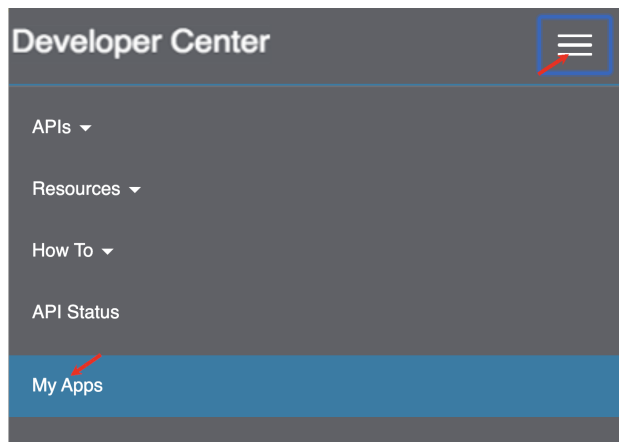


- In the DataGrail Portal, if you have any other integrations not connected (no green check mark) please click Connect to complete the configuration and reference the Help Docs link for instructions

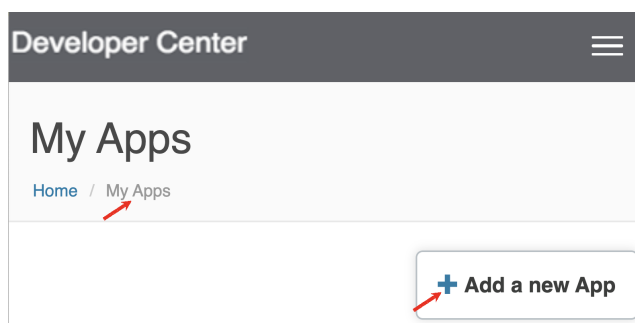
GoToWebinar Integration

Step 1: Get Client ID and Client Secret

- Register for a [GoTo Developer Center](#) account.
- Login to [GoTo Developer Center](#) with your account.
- Navigate to My Apps page.



- Click the Add a new App button on the My Apps page.



- Configure the new application:
 - Add name and description.
 - Choose GoToWebinar in the Product API list.
 - Set Application URL as: <https://datagrail.io/oauth/gotowebinar>

- GoToMeeting
- GoToWebinar
- GoToAssist
- GoToAssistCorporate

Application URL *

Enter your own redirect URL for the OAuth flow. If you plan to use the Direct Login flow, enter "https://api.getgo.com" or any other URL.
You can provide multiple redirect URLs by separating them with commas.

Create App

- Click the Create App button.
- Click on the new application name on the My Apps page.
- Copy the Consumer Key (Client ID) and Consumer Secret (Client Secret).

- Click Connect within the Integration page for GoToWebinar.




- Enter the Client ID and the Client Secret obtained from Step 1.

- Click Connect GoToWebinar







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- If there are additional GoToWebinar accounts to integrate follow these instructions:
 - Click Edit Connection within the Integration page for GoToWebinar.
 - From the drop-down, select +Add New Connection.
 - Under Connection Name, enter a new name to identify this separate account (ex: GoToWebinar Training Account).
 - Repeat Step 1 to get the Client ID and the Client Secret for this new account.
 - Enter the Client ID and the Client Secret obtained from Step 1.
 - Click Connect.
